THE AMERICAN HOTEL, SAC HARBOR In 1846 and at the height of this town's whaling prosperity, this eight-room brick hotel was erected on Main Street. Today it holds every bit of its integrity and more through a noticeably cozy and charming lobby complete with antique check-in counter, easy chairs and couches opening to the a pub area with an old wood original bar. The outside is just as special with a front porch filled with tables and chairs on which you can enjoy a glass of wine, read the paper or just people watch.
